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OVERVIEW

In this document, students will find the courses required for each Minor pathway at Raventree Academy, as well as a brief description about the foci of each Minor. A separate document outlines the requirements for each Major pathway at Raventree. If you have any questions regarding requirements or are seeking general advice on courses to enroll in, please contact the Office of Student Affairs.

Students may not pursue a minor in their Major; that is to say, students who pursue a Wortcunning Major cannot receive a Minor in Wortcunning as well. However, students may receive a Minor in the same Discipline as their Major, if they so choose to.

At Raventree Academy, a Minor consists of a minimum of 28 credits in total. Please note that Minors do not have general elective courses – Minors are firmly structured around a sequence of courses, as decided upon by faculty and curriculum staff. If you are seeking course replacements or alternatives, please contact the Dean of the Discipline of the Minor you are interested. Students are free to pursue as many or as few Minors as they wish at Raventree.

WORTCUNNING & ALCHEMY MINORS

Discipline: Alchemy & Wortcunning

Overview: Minors in this Discipline include Alchemical Studies, Wortcunning Studies, and Spagyrics. Alchemy Studies focuses primarily on the history and practice of alchemy, both material and spiritual. Wortcunning Studies focuses on herbs and their role within magick and healing. Finally, the Spagyrics Minor specializes in the art of forming herbal formulas, potions, and other brews and philtres.
