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OVERVIEW

In this document, students will find the courses required for Spellcraft Minor pathways at Raventree Academy, as well as a brief description about the foci of each Minor. A separate document outlines the requirements for the Spellcraft Major pathway at Raventree. If you have any questions regarding requirements or are seeking general advice on courses to enroll in, please contact the Office of Student Affairs or Spellcraft Office.

Students may not pursue a minor in their Major; that is to say, students who pursue a Spellcraft Major cannot receive a Minor in Spellcasting as well. However, students may receive a Minor in the same Discipline as their Major, if they so choose to.

At Raventree Academy, a Minor consists of a minimum of 28 credits in total. Please note that Minors do not have general elective courses – Minors are firmly structured around a sequence of courses, as decided upon by faculty and curriculum staff. If you are seeking course replacements or alternatives, please contact the Dean of the Discipline of the Minor you are interested. Students are free to pursue as many or as few Minors as they wish at Raventree.
